Guide to the Confederación Campesina del Perú Archive (CCP)

There are two entry points for the CCP collection in UCLA Library Digital Collections:

- Go directly to the <u>collection's page</u>. There you will find detailed information and guides for your research. To access these documents, click in "<u>Browse items in this</u> collection".
- 2) Do a general search in <u>UCLA Library Digital Collections</u>. You can use the filters on the left, "Collection" or "Repository," to limit your search to the Confederación Campesina del Perú collection.

Access to the collection is free and does not require opening an account or requesting special access in order to review documents. UCLA's digital collection is in English and there are no translation options. However, each document in the CCP collection counts on a description in both Spanish and English.

The platform offers 10 results per page, ordered alphabetically. Both the number and order can be changed. You can have 10, 20, 50, or 100 results per page and they can be in alphabetical or chronological order or by relevance. The number bar allows you to move through the results



The page shows you a single image of the entry and its title. You can change from Gallery to List View for a more complete overview of each document, with Description, Date and Resource Type.



The sidebar offers specific filters: Subject, Resource Type, Genre, Date, Language, Collection, and Repository. In this collection, two filters are especially important:

- a) Subject. Every document has up to five key words, which can be used to improve the search. You can search by departments (Peru's subnational political jurisdictions), administrative units, or type of documents.
- b) Date. The collection has documents ranging from 1909 to 2002. The majority are from 1980 to 2002.

When you select a document, a page will open that allows you to review each page of the folder. The images are in high resolution so you can focus in for clarity. You can download each document in low or high resolution.



On the bottom right of the page you can find information such as dates, description, keywords, and more. On the right you will see the information about the document. Specifically, the "local identifier" can be used to cite the document.



Frequent questions

- 1) Do some documents have restricted access?
 - No. All the documents are open access. You do not need to open an account or request permission. We do request that you follow normal standards in citing the document (see below).
- 2) Can I download an entire series in PDF?
 - No. You can only download individual documents
- 3) Have all the documents in the CCP Archive been digitized?
 - No. Only the main sections, specifically material from 1980-2000. This is the richest material for researchers.
- 4) Where can I review physical copies of the documents?
 - The documents belong to the Confederación Campesina del Perú (Lima). Currently they do not count on an adequate locale for these requests.
- 5) Who was in charge of the digitalization?
