Central to Mary Heebner's practice is her interest in the spiritual qualities of the natural world and their expression in cultural and natural forms. The artist's inquisitive practice draws from her extensive international travels for inspiration. The interpretative license of her work remains grounded however, in a sense of context that reflects a cultivated sensitivity to the distinct mythology, geology, archaeology, language and customs of each cultural exploration she undertakes.

Skilled at the art of papermaking, Heebner incorporates her unique interpretation of landforms, maps, water forms and antiquities to create sensually abstract compositions. The artist uncovers a spiritual beauty in the earth and its history, and strives to capture, and in some ways re-create, the warmth and wonder its relics hold.

Heebner has distinguished herself as an abstract artist, writer and book artist, and her pieces are held in numerous esteemed public and private collections. In addition to her fine art practice, Heebner has published fine art press books under the imprint simplemente maria press, as well as two additional book publications that feature her paintings alongside Pablo Neruda's poetry.
